@ CAN YOU HANDLE WORDS ADEQUATELY?

Do you too often run out of words? Do you usually remain silent while somebody else carries the conversation? Do your own ideas go unsaid and untried because you could not put them into the right words? Do you think every time you fail in convincing people, or that they fail to understand you? No wonder, students who study in English medium (English as their first language) too grope for words and fail miserably in competitive entrance exams like TOEFL, CAT, GMAT, GRE, etc. Their poor writing skill is due to lack of adequate word power. When you grope for words you lose thought fluency. No words, no thoughts.

We have to develop these competencies with persistent hard work with words. A native speaker of English acquires 'the English linguistic behaviour naturally, ecologically'. Note that fluency and accuracy is impossible without words. You will not become a fluent speaker and writer in English if you do not have adequate word power. Mastering grammar is one part of it. You must now words. Words are the dress of your thoughts.

Words are required for human experiences. The word 'happy' holds a permanent meaning which we can 'feel'; at least we can imagine when we hear that 'someone is happy.' Thus, we can experience without words, but to convey to others our experience we have to have words. If we lack the required word power, we will fail to express, even though we have felt or have had intense experiences. These experiences will keep struggling for expression in our heart. Without right words we will just 'manage to express'.

You must understand that most of our vocabulary is accidental and hence inadequate. You need independent, focussed, committed effort to learn new words.

Introspect your English.

Do you find that you make embarrassing errors and mistakes while speaking and writing English? Is this killing your confidence in speaking English fluently?

Even highly qualified people commit embarrassing mistakes and errors in spoken and written English. These may be related to grammar, word usage (you might be choosing wrong words), etc. This reflects very badly on their personality and individuality. Your language reveals your attitude towards everything.

Rightly said, “You are not more than your language.” If you use your language in an abusive way, you will leave a bad impression. It can even shock your audience. When you speak or write you are revealing yourself – YOUR ‘SELF.’ Your language will make or mar you. You create your own world with your language.

But you are not to be blamed for your wrong English. Mind you, studying in English medium does not assure accuracy in the English usage. Read what Maharashtra State Bureau of Textbook Production and Curriculum Research (Government of Maharashtra) has to say here.

It is found that many English medium students, owing to many reasons, speak broken English. (It is Hindi plus English - **Hinglish**). Many have fluency but lack accuracy. Maharashtra State Bureau of Textbook Production and Curriculum Research of Government of Maharashtra has given the answer to this question in the preface to KUMARBHARTI Std. IX. The Board has clarified that ‘*greater attention has been paid to language than to literature. This decision to play up language stems from a belief that the student of English-as-first-language has fluency but often lacks accuracy. Also he/she has adequate proficiency in listening and speaking but often lacks the ability to read and write well enough. Therefore, the four language skills, reading and writing have been emphasised.*’

Shri. J.R.D. Tata, the Bharat Ratna once said 'a good plumber is better than a bad scientist.' Personal excellence is the real worth of a person.

Frequently Asked Questions

@ *Can one learn English by self-study?*

Firstly, this course is not a basic level course. This is essentially a skills building and enhancement course aimed at giving higher fluency in English. It is not aimed at making you a mere talkative person. It is to train you in the fine art of effective speaking and writing.

It aims at training you to speak and write in a very influential way. You might have believed until now that you have problems with word power, structures of the English language, practice, etc. Significantly, fluency in spoken English is more than that. Please note that our basic objective goes beyond making you mere fluent speaker. We aim at developing your power of expression. It trains you in the precious skill of meaningful, effective, and influential communication.

It is basically for those who already have reasonable command over the English language and want to sharpen their communicative competence in spoken English. That is why we believe our learners are to be advanced learners in the sense that they have enough command over English to learn new techniques.

Please note the word 'techniques'. These fluency-related techniques could be mastered only by self study method. People think that spoken English is just 'practice-oriented'. This is true in the case of beginners. Now you need not to back to the basics.

Fluency and Accuracy Development Course is for professionals, executives, academicians, and those going abroad for higher responsibilities.

Now turning to your question- Can one become an accomplished user of English by self-study? Please DO NOT underestimate your own inborn capabilities to learn new things on your own. Every child has this ability to learn things on his own. He masters languages even before going to school. How? Just be listening and speaking – that is, by actually by doing it – going through the learning process, on his own. Note that language learning is essentially and fundamentally self-learning.

Language experts firmly believe that language learning is basically acquiring a new behaviour. It is like learning to play a new musical instrument like Violin. Your instructor will instruct you, tell you more about it; but it is **YOU** who must work with it. Your teacher will not practice for you. There is no substitute to self-study and self-training. So nothing great that you must work hard. (Mind you, the word 'Success' comes before the word 'Work' only in a dictionary.) The same way for learning new words. The only way to attain excellence is to work hard for it.

Linguistically speaking, language learning is an ecological process. Look at a child. Any child has the inborn ability to learn to speak many languages on its own. The child can speak well even before going to school and knowing syllables or anything of grammar. At last language is nothing but a definite, distinct sound system. Words are nothing but unique sounds. We learn such sounds automatically.

That is why language learning is quite different from learning other subjects. In language learning the learner is at the centre. The responsibility is on the learner. He has to become a sponge to absorb new structures, expressions, words, subtleties, sounds and rhythms, etc.

WFAD course is a highly acclaimed, proven tool for self-learning. Hundreds have benefited from it. Of course, you must work hard. Learning new words is never easy. You have to be committed and hard working. You must have the determination and intense passion to acquire new words and higher language. A learner must always be vigilant and greedy to learn and earn new words and expressions.

If you do not work hard then the words will go back to dictionary. You cannot speak and write effectively just by buying and carrying with you all the good dictionaries in the world. No one can become a master in any subject by merely opening a library at home. You will not learn to swim just by watching others swim. You have to jump into the water. Deeper the water, the better swimmer you become.

WFAD is designed in such a way that it exploits your own inborn, natural faculties to learn the higher aspects of the language in a very structured and systematic way.

A good teacher essentially does the same. He must enable the learner to use his own abilities to learn new things on his own. Don't you understand meanings of new words you come across in newspapers? Even the context is enough to give you the meaning. You do not go back to your English teacher to know the meanings of every new word. A good teacher always makes his student independent, self-learners. A teacher is not always available to you. It is fundamentally wrong even if this is possible. One must fly with one's own wings. WFAD aspires to give you your own wings of self-learning. That is what we mean when we call you an 'advanced learner'.

Ancient India had the *Gurukul* tradition. The Guru would train his pupils in the art of using their own natural abilities to learn new things and face life. The Guru would go beyond instructing and teaching, he would actually train his pupils. Our ancient educational system was based on the realisation that what one mind is capable of conceiving and achieving, the other is capable of learning and acquiring. That is why ancient languages like Sanskrit reached to the summit of glory and excellence. Great literature could be created in these languages. Tragically, our education system is such that it is essentially exam oriented. That is why we have a lot of teaching, no learning. It just stuffs the student's brain with all information without developing his inborn abilities for self-learning. Self-learning is independence. In our educational institutes language teaching does not result into a learning process. We believe the greatest task and duty of a teacher is to enable his student to explore his own inborn capabilities. That should be the true measure of his success as a teacher. To help the pupil raise the sails of his own powers and venture out into the uncharted waters of life.

In today's education system, students study not for knowledge but for higher grades in examinations. This rat race for higher grades in examinations has resulted in excessive dependence upon digests, paper solutions, coaching classes, etc. Hardly a few students read even text books. The end result is that the student's mind is stuffed. The inner side gets no opportunity for expression. Nothing is tested more than his memory.

Language learning is essentially a joyful experience. It is something that naturally happens to us all. But due to very faulty manner of teaching English most of the students find English (the subject) as a devil that they have to take on the examinations. Despite well-meaning efforts, English is still taught for examinations and not as a language of global communication. Hence, no excellence in English required for career development.

I have come across school students as well as professionals who can't even generate a passage of their own in their own words. The root cause of this handicap could be found in the teachers who give ready made essays or make students mug up the whole essay. We have found the tendency that what the students can't understand write on their own, they go on mugging it up. As self-learning abilities are not properly and adequately harnessed in schools and colleges, many people have self-doubt about education by distance mode. In fact, they being the victims of an insensate education system are not to be blamed. Distance education has emerged as a trusted mode of learning.

That is why one must study English independently for achieving higher excellence in its usage.

No one can teach a person better than his own convinced mind. Nothing can be taught to an unreceptive mind. Mind becomes receptive with the ability to learn through self-study. Think it over and you will agree with us. This is especially true in the case of learning a new language.

So be sure, you can definitely learn hundreds of new words of the English language and achieve higher competency in English by studying this excellent course. Note that a lot of research has gone into the making of this course and hundreds have achieved higher excellence by WFAD through self-study method.

@ Why can't I speak and write English effectively though I have been studying in English medium for years?

Just go back right up to your school days and introspect. Did they teach you English as an international language of communication? Definitely not!

Management trainers legitimately expect learners to have sound knowledge of words. Inadequate vocabulary indicates that the learner has no power of understanding. No wonder, everyone is vocabulary -conscious today.

Understandably, what we do not understand well we cannot control and use effectively. **What we cannot state clearly, we do not know** (we cannot even claim that know it.) **A limited vocabulary restricts critical thinking** as thought is impossible without words. Also, in order to understand other people are thinking (expressed in spoken and written English), one must have excellent, enriched vocabulary. Right words at right time give us the critical ability of precise thinking and precise, accurate expression. To understand what Drucker, Toffler, Kotler, Porter, Das, Palkhivala and others think and say one must know their vocabulary, i.e. the words with which they think, the very tools of their thoughts. **Thought is impossible without words.**

Words are the immediate gift of god to man. Thought is impossible without words. The whole knowledge is stored in words. According to language scientists, words hold a key to success; your vocabulary is related directly to your accomplishments. Success and vocabulary go hand in hand. No wonder, you have those vocabulary tests as ability tests. Your words are the voice of your mind. Without words you cannot learn nor can communicate. A person is what his language is. Your language reveals your attitude.

In this era of information explosion excellent fluency in English is a great personal competitive advantage. This is most valid in today's networked world. Technologies like Internet have made information accessible to one and all. But very few can convert it into knowledge. You must have the ability to derive knowledge out of information. Information is not knowledge. If your language skills are poor you cannot handle and exploit information effectively and get knowledge out of it. Information goes, knowledge remains. So your superiority is directly linked to your excellence in the English language.

Technology is a great leveller and internet has ended the monopoly of information and knowledge. Now the real competitive advantage will come from the ability to understand and manipulate information to extract required knowledge. It will decide the winner. Of course, you do not have to study literature and get a masters degree to achieve higher excellence in English.

Strangely those who study English literature may not have excellence in English.

You can not control what you do not understand. What you do not understand very well not of much use to you. You cannot exploit it to its fullest potential. The command over the medium of information will be a crucial factor in the new knowledge-economy era. Any delay in achieving excellence in communication skills will prove costly at all levels. This is especially important when the medium of knowledge is a global one. Only excellent command over the medium of knowledge can give you equality of opportunity. That is the secret of the success of India's software professionals. The secret is their knowledge of English. Chinese, Japanese and Germans and even French are realising this fact to their bitterness. No wonder, China has taken up teaching of English on war footing. China wants to teach English to her 25 crore school students within a decade from now. Chinese education minister toured India scouting for 10,000 Indian teachers of the English language. Thus, increasingly, it is the mastery over the medium of information that will decide your competitiveness. This is valid in case of individuals as well as that of nation-states.

Professionals must urgently sharpen their communication skills in English. One cannot afford to lose important opportunities. One major problem area in their higher career progression is their lack of fluency. Professionals have excellent functional knowledge but are found wanting in excellent communication skills. Don't you read in placement ads for higher positions like Vice Presidents, CEOs demanding 'excellent communication skills'?

We believe that India is facing acute shortage of skilled IT professionals not because there are very few; but because there are many who were not selected as worthy of work due to their lack of spoken communication skills. They fail in the selection process. Many fail in interview itself. Myths about fluency

Please understand very well that becoming fluent in English is different and knowing about English is different.

A five-year-old child speaks very fluently at the level of his understanding of the language that he gets to listen. For this child fluency is definitely not a matter of advanced learning. It is essentially a matter of natural absorption and forming speech habits. To put it simply, it is an ability to play with words, with habitual ease.

Fluency development is essentially mind training.

Fluency for Personal Power

There are only two types of people - those who can communicate effectively and those who cannot.

You will survive by your ability to communicate effectively. If you are an executive, think over this statement critically and you will soon realise the fact that much of your time is spent in communicating - especially speaking to people to get the things done.

Today business is effective communication. And effective communication does mean speaking with fluency.

But it is not just fluency that is important. Accuracy of what you speak is equally important. Wrong, error-ridden speech can not be an effective communication. It may backfire cutting a sorry figure of you.

Your learning vocabulary is basically and largely accidental. They are not expected to master the English language but to master their area of knowledge (marketing, finance, etc.) That is why many high-calibre professionals with remarkable expertise in their functional fields yet are very poor in communication. This puts you at a serious disadvantage in today's knowledge-based era where business is successful communication. They use clichés and most of their words are rather 'worn-out words'. They cannot become effective, critical thinkers with a poor vocabulary which seriously impacts their managerial and organisational effectiveness.

UNDERSTANDING THE LANGUAGE SYSTEM

As rightly defined, language is "a set of human habits, the purpose of which is to give expression to thoughts and feelings." The very use of system of language is on the habit level; we ordinarily do not make conscious choices of words and sounds when we operate the language system. The native speaker of a language does not have never to think of the position of different speech organs, nor has he to make any conscious effort to arrange words in speech or writing. Words have a spontaneous flow. It is a matter of habit for the speaker to arrange them in the order in which others hear them. These language habits are formed by continuous practice. If you have not received this practise, you will have problems in speaking fluently. But thankfully, habits can be formed at any time and hence, training and practice can form fluency as a habit of speech generation. This has to be 'mind-training'. Fluency comes from our habitual ability to arrange words to make sense. Many things play their part in this process which is essentially a process of text generation.

Language system operates on two aims:

***Reception and
Expression***

Reception and Expression are the two main aims of any language. A language is first received and understood and then expressed. In language learning four skills are involved. These skills are: listening and understanding (at this stage we speak as we form habits), reading and understanding, speaking and writing.

Fluency will depend on acquiring necessary speech habits.

But as the child grows, his speech habits prove to be inadequate to express all that he has to or that he feels. Note that for feeling words are not essential. That is very much an internal process. But as he grows up, his language skills also grow dynamically. He masters new structures and expression units to satisfy his requirements. This he does by self-training. To say that fluency development is a matter of advanced learning is like saying that billions of grown-up people still lack it; and as they do not speak fluently as they have received no advanced training in fluency development. Are they not communicating with each other fluently?

Fluency is not limited to spoken part only. Written fluency is also based on the same fundamentals. Fluency development is basically a natural process involving some technical processes. Dolphins jump fluently to express themselves. Tools differ, basics remain the same. Fluency could be viewed as transparency of ideas in verbally expressed manner. It is an unhindered flow of thoughts from one source to another.

Most people who lack fluency should understand that they need to undergo a definite learning process. For example, you have to learn certain words (mainly by sound) and structures if at all you want to use them. What you do not know does not exist for you.

It is something within us, which needs to be taken out truthfully.

In learning a language (especially a foreign language), mastery of structures is more important than mere acquisition of vocabulary. Simple, usual words too are enough. It is better to know how to use the words we know with various shades of their meanings than merely knowing thousands of words.

Range of word power is instrumental in expressing a wide range of human experiences. We feel but for the want of precise, equivalent words; effective, precise expression becomes difficult.

In our schools the main approach to teaching of English has been that 'English is a library language', thus reading and writing are more emphasised than speaking.

That is one of the several causes for your lack of fluency.

Many people have good word power, but they fail in expressing what is on their mind.

Why?

This may be happening in your case too.

The reason for this is that you were never fully and rightly trained to 'express verbally'. You were trained to express your mind in 'written form'. You need practice of 'expressing' your human experiences. The experienced you never learnt to express, you can never express ably. At least, you should receive the opportunity to learn by listening from others expressing their experiences. This is the process of natural absorption of other's expressions. We are the source of each other's education.

But this requires training, self-training. As listening is a vital fundamental skill in language learning process. It is essentially developed by self-study, self-endeavour. No one else can study it for you.

The first, he said, were the Athenians, who lived in Greece 2500 years ago. They developed the alphabet; they invented the idea of political democracy, philosophy, logic, rhetoric and came very close to inventing what we call science. They composed epic poems of unsurpassed beauty and insight. They wrote and performed plays that even today have the power to make audiences laugh and weep. They even invented what, today, we call the Olympics. They believed in reason, in beauty, in moderation. About 2,000 years ago, these people began to disappear. But what they had created did not disappear. Their imagination, art, politics, literature, spread all over the world so that, today, it is hardly possible to speak on any subject without repeating what some Athenian said on the matter 2,500 years ago.

The second group of people, called the Goths, lived about 1700 years ago in the place we now call Germany. They were spectacular horsemen, and that is about the only good thing one can say of them. They were marauders -- ruthless and brutal. Their language lacked subtlety and depth. Their art was crude and grotesque. They swept through Europe, burning books, smashing works of art, destroying everything in their path, and they overran the Roman Empire. The Goths left no poetry, no theatre, no logic, no science, no humane politics.

Like the Athenians, the Goths also disappeared, but not before they had ushered in the period known as the Dark Ages. It took Europe almost a thousand years to recover from the after-effects of the Goths and their like.

To be an Athenian is to value language as being humankind's most precious gift, and to strive for grace, precision, and variety in its use. To a Goth, one word is as good as another, and a Goth's language aspires to nothing higher than the cliché.
